“**Japan’s Central Asian Diplomacy in Global Politics: Historical and Future Perspectives**”.



The lecture will be presented by Dr. Tomohiko Uyama, professor of Central Eurasian Studies at Hokkaido University. Dr. Uyama is the President of the Japan Association for Central Asian Studies and a former director of the Slavic-Eurasian Research Center at Hokkaido University. Professor Uyama was an invited scholar at the Institute of Oriental Studies of the National Academy of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 1995-1996, and an attaché (political analysis expert) at the Embassy of Japan in the Republic of Kazakhstan in 1994-1995. Dr. Uyama has published extensively, authoring and editing 18 books, and writing over 180 articles on the history, politics, and international relations of Central Asia and other global issues.

The lecture will be delivered in **Russian**. Professor Tomohiko Uyama will talk about the historical background of Japan’s diplomacy towards Central Asia, its development in the past decades, and its present state in the context of broader international relations in Eurasia. He also aims to explore the roles of Japan and Central Asian states in the dynamically changing world order.
