MIRAI: Mutual-understanding, Intellectual Relations and Academic Exchange Initiative

- Launched in 2015.
- Invites theme-oriented groups of **promising young leaders** who are expected to play an active role in Europe.
- Provides opportunities to have **intellectual exchanges** with Japanese experts, scholars, and students from the same generation.
- All participants are expected to **share Japan's diplomacy and the charm of Japan** proactively through social media and other media during and after the program.

Opportunity for exchange with Japanese scholars and students

1. Objectives

- To promote **better understanding of Japan** and obtain **strong support** among young generation.
- To develop **a deep mutual understanding** and **friendly relations between Japan and Europe** into the future.



2. Overview

- MIRAI is intended for graduate, undergraduate students, and young professionals from Europe, Central Asia and Caucasus region.
- Period : Approximately 7 days
- Number of Participants : 69 (TBD)



3. Sample Itinerary

■ Pre-exchange Program (Online)

- Orientation for participants
- Lecture on the theme-related contents
- Virtual exchange and discussion with Japanese students/ experts

■ Program in Japan

- 4 days in Tokyo and 2 days in other cities
- Lectures on Japan and its major policies
- Visiting Japanese companies/ research institutes/ historical sites
- Discussions with Japanese young students / experts at universities / think-tanks
- Homestay

■ Debriefing session

- Identifying what participants learned
- Analyzing outcomes
- Farewell party
